

- Scan Weight Date MUST be within 7 Days of scan date
- Test Type:
 - R = Ranch Test
 - C = Central Test
 - D = Developing Heifer
 - F = Feedlot
- Diet:
 - 0 = unknown
 - 1 = 0% concentrate
 - 2 = <= 50% concentrate
 - 3 = >50% concentrate
- Group Code – breeders are to use a single digit letter (A, B, C, etc.) group code to distinguish how the animals listed on this barn sheet are to be grouped into contemporary groups. Only animals that are reared together and managed in the same manner (diet, health practices, etc.) are to be in the same contemporary group.
- Diet – a diet code of 0% concentrate contains no grain. Animals on pasture, and perhaps supplemented with hay, are on a 0% concentrate diet. Whole plant corn silage, without the addition of more corn or other grains, would describe a 50% concentrate diet. If the whole plant corn silage diet was also supplemented with hay, then the diet would be <=50% concentrate. A whole plant corn silage diet supplemented with corn or other grains would be >50% concentrate. An earlage diet would be approximately a 75% concentrate diet.
- A separate Barn Sheet MUST be used for each member herd number
- The member should fill out the animal information prior to technicians arrival
