Crisp autumn days greeted 101 buyers from 11 states at the 16th Annual Santa Gertrudis and Brangus Bull and Commercial Female Sale, and the 42nd Annual TriStar Sale at Briggs Ranches, Bloomington, Texas. The female sale featured an impressive lineup of donors and future donors. The bull sale hosted the best set of well-conditioned bulls ever presented at Briggs Ranches.

The high-selling herd sire, Lot 1A, Harris Pistol 253F6, was consigned by Harris Riverbend Farms, Cleburne, Texas, and was sold to Vesper Ranches, Kelly Vesper, Cotulla, Texas, for \$20,000. 253F6 is a full brother to Pistollero that is owned by Quail Valley Farm, Oneonta, Ala., and Tinney Farms, Hanceville, Ala.
